(LAFCO)

SUMMARY

The Ventura Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCo) was formed and operates under the provisions of state law, specifically what is now known as the Cortese-Knox-Hertzberg Act of 2000. LAFCo's implement state law requirements and state and local policies relating to boundary changes for cities and most special districts, including spheres of influence, incorporations, annexations, reorganizations and other changes.

BACKGROUND

All LAFCo's have the following general objectives and authorities:

Objectives:

- 1. Encourage the orderly formation and expansion of local government agencies
- 2. Preserve agricultural land resources
- 3. Discourage urban sprawl

Authorities:

- 1. Regulate boundary changes
- 2. Establish spheres of influence the probable physical boundaries and services area of a city or special district
- 3. Initiate special district consolidations or dissolutions
- 4. Act on out of agency service agreements between public agencies and between public agencies and private parties.

DISCUSSION


As per government code, every five years Ventura LAFCo must review and update each sphere of influence as necessary for every city and special district in Ventura County. In 2015, the Commission approved the Municipal Service Review report which included the District. This update was conducted in conjunction with the Conejo and Rancho Simi Recreation & Park Districts. Currently, the District is due for a review in the year 2020, however the District may request a Municipal Service Review prior to the five-year period.
