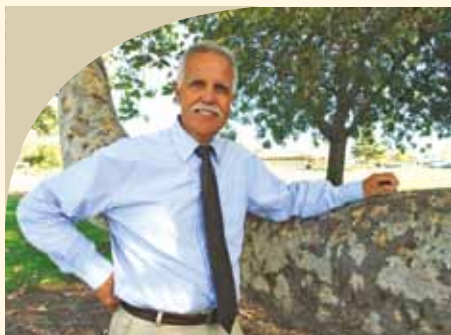


A Message from the General Manager
