STEP 3: PARADE RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. A participant from your entry must check-in at the corner of Temple and Aloha prior to vehicle entering staging.
2. Follow the directions and instructions given to you and your group by the PVRPD Event Staff.
3. Do not park cars or other vehicles that are not part of your unit(s) in the staging area (Temple Ave.)
4. **Parade units MAY NOT stop along the parade route unless otherwise designated.** PVRPD Event Staff's instructions to resume movement must be acted on promptly. All units must keep pace with the unit ahead of them to ensure there are no unreasonable gaps which interrupt the flow of the parade.
5. As a safety precaution, no candy or other objects shall be thrown or handed out on the parade route.
6. Participants shall clean up any debris or materials left in the staging area by your unit(s). This includes those units with animals and waste disposal.
7. Owners of parade vehicles shall ensure that such vehicles are insured as required by California law.
8. Drivers of motor vehicles must remain with the vehicles at all times.
9. Parade units violating any of these or rules contained in the Float Manual, may be denied entry in future parades.
10. You will receive an entry packet 1 week prior to the parade. Share this with everyone in your entry.

HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT

I, the undersigned, in consideration of my request and permission to participate in the Camarillo Christmas Parade facilitated by the Pleasant Valley Recreation and Park District, hereby assume full responsibility for all risk of injury or loss which may result from my participation in this activity and hereby AGREE TO DEFEND, INDEMNIFY, HOLD HARMLESS, RELEASE AND FOREVER DISCHARGE the Pleasant Valley Recreation and Park District, its respective officers, employees, independent contractors and other agents and representatives ("the District"), past and present, from any and all acts of negligence and all claims and demands whatsoever, which the undersigned, any third person, or any persons acting under their behalf, have or may have against the District by reason of any accident, illness, injury to or death of any person(s), or damage to or loss or destruction of any property arising or resulting directly or indirectly from participation in the referenced activity and occurring during said participation, or any time subsequent thereto. The terms of this release will serve as a release and assumption of risk for my executors and administrators and for all of my family members. I agree that to the best of my knowledge, I have no medical, physical, mental or emotional health condition, which would hinder or prevent my active participation in the activity referenced above.
